DELAWARE thus wins its first M.A.C. team title in history, marking the first time since 1951 that a Philadelphia college (La Salle or St. Joseph's) did not win the University Division Championship. LAFAYETTE was the last such school to do so, in 1951. ST. JOSEPH'S was the defending champion, having won University Division titles in 1962 and 1961.

URSINUS' College Division Championship breaks the four year string of WEST CHESTER, which had won the title every year since 1959, when the M.A.C. was divided into divisions for the track and field championships. West Chester sent only a token squad to the M.A.C. championships this year deciding to concentrate on the state College championships instead.
